1. James 1:5
If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you.
Prayer: Lord God, keep my desires aligned with your purpose for my life.

2. 1 Peter 2:1
Therefore, rid yourselves of all malice and all deceit, hypocrisy, envy, and slander of every kind.
Prayer: Master, thank you for the spirit of discernment that leads me in the way of truth.

3. 1 Peter 4:14
If you are insulted because of the name of Christ, you are blessed, for the Spirit of glory and of God rests on you.
Prayer: Lord, I am your child – you promised never to leave me nor forsake me.

4. 2 Corinthians 4:8-9
We are hard pressed on every side, but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed.
Prayer: Thank you Holy Father for the Holy Ghost within me that gives me strength to overcome the frailties of the flesh.

5. Galatians 5:16
