1. John 14:21
He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him.
Prayer: Lord, thank You for loving me and for the privilege of loving and obeying You.

2. John 13:34
A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another as I have loved you, that you also love one another.
Prayer: Father God, You are Love; and if I am Your child, I must love You and my brothers and sisters.

3. Luke 6:27
But I say to you who hear: Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you.
Prayer: Holy Father, some people do evil to us but help us to do good to them in return and to love them anyway.

4. Luke 6:31
And just as you want men to do to you, you do to them likewise.
Prayer: Father, help me to always remember that the love I sow is the love I can expect to reap.

5. Jude 21
Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.
Prayer: Father, I want to draw closer to You in my earthly life and to live with You in my eternal life.

6. 1 John 4:21
And this commandment we have from Him: that he who loves God must love his brother also.
Prayer: Holy Father, You have commanded us to love so many times in Your Word. Therefore I know that loving You and others is a priority. Help me to obey.

7. 1 Peter 5:7
Casting all your cares upon Him for He cares for you.
Prayer: Thank You heavenly Father for giving me the privilege of bringing my cares, burdens and troubles to You. I am grateful.

8. Hebrews 12:6
For whom the Lord loves He chastens, and scourges every son He receives.
Prayer: Thank You Father for loving me enough to discipline me when I need it. I understand that your discipline helps to mold me into who You would have me become.

9. Ephesians 4:2-3
With all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love, endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.
Prayer: Holy Spirit, may I produce the fruit that You so generously plant within my heart.

10. Ephesians 4:32
And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as Christ forgave you.
Prayer: Lord Jesus, when I think of how kind and gracious You are to me; how can I not be the same to my brothers and sisters who You also love!

11. Galatians 6:2
Bear one another's burdens and so fulfill the law of Christ.
Prayer: Lord Jesus, You have shown me in so many Scriptures of how I am to love and to treat others. May I be obedient to Your Word.

12. Galatians 6:10
Therefore as we have the opportunity, let us do good to all, especially to those who are of the household of faith.
Prayer: Father, I am reminded often to do good to others – even the ones who mean evil for me.

13. 1 Corinthians 16:14
Let all that you do be done in love.
Prayer: Father, You are Love and You have loved me with an everlasting love. Therefore, I am to love others with a godly love in all of my actions.

14. Matthew 5:44
But I say to you, love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you.
Prayer: Dear Lord Jesus, You are the perfect model to show us how to love our enemies.

15. Matthew 7:1-2
Judge not that you be not judged. For with what judgment you judge, you will be judged; and with what measure you use, it will be measured back to you.
Prayer: Holy Father, may I always remember that judgment belongs to You. I don't know enough to judge.

16. John 14:15-16
If you love Me, keep my commandments. And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever –
Prayer: Lord Jesus, I do love You and I am grateful for the Holy Spirit Who dwells within me to help me along life's journey.

17. John 14:26
But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, Whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things I have said to you.
Prayer: Thank You Holy Spirit for Your guidance and for teaching me and keeping me.

18. John 16:33
These things I have spoken to you, that in Me, you may have peace, in the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.
Prayer: Lord Jesus, even though there is trouble and turmoil worldwide, I can have inner peace that comes only from You.

19. Philippians 2:3
Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself.
Prayer: Father, help me to always put aside my desires and focus instead of how to lift others.

20. Philippians 2:4
Let each of you look out not only for his own interest, but also for the interests of others.
Prayer: Lord Jesus, You have shown me in so many ways the importance of looking out for others. You were the perfect example when You died on the cross for the sins of others.

21. Philippians 4:4-5
Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say rejoice! Let your gentleness be known to all men. The Lord is at hand.
Prayer: Christ Jesus, when I think of all You have done for me, I cannot but rejoice. Praise Your holy name!

22. 1 John 4:8
He who does not love does not know God, for God is love.
Prayer: Thank You Lord that You are love. Because You are love, I can love.

23. 1 John 4:12
No one has seen God at any time. If we love one another, God abides in us, and His love has been perfected in us.
Prayer: Father, You are Spirit and I can't see You, but I know that You live within me.

24. 1 John 4:18
There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love.
Prayer: Thank You Lord for love. Knowing that You love me and that I love You keeps me from having a spirit of fear.

25. Philippians 4:19
And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.
Prayer: Heavenly Father, I am grateful that You supply everything that I need because I am Your child.

26. 1 Corinthians 13:4
Love suffers long and is kind; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up.
Prayer: Lord, may I always be a model of love – to show the love of Christ in me.

27. 1 Corinthians 13:13
And now abide faith, hope and love, these three; but the greatest of these is love.
Prayer: Thank You Lord Jesus that Your love is everlasting.

28. Romans 12:10
Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another;
Prayer: Father, help me to always be kind and loving to others.

29. Romans 5:8
But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
Prayer: Thank You Lord Jesus for the love that You showed me when I was still a sinner and unworthy. You provided salvation for my soul!

30. 1 John 4:19
We love Him because He first loved us.
Prayer: Christ Jesus, it is only through Your great love for me that I can love You in return. Thank You.

31. 1 John 4:7
Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God.
Prayer: Father, I know that true love is of You and from You. Empower me to demonstrate true love.
